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Ms. Reardon called the meeting to order at 2:02 p.m.

Minutes Review

The minutes from the March 8, 2022 meeting were sent to the RCAC ahead of the meeting and were affirmed by the council with no changes

Legislative Update

Mr. Mabe gave an update on legislation that is pending in the Ohio General Assembly of interest to the Medical Board. He indicated that the OGA is in recess until mid-November of 2022.

Statutory Topics for Discussion

The SMBO Rules status sheet was provided to the council ahead of time for review. An update was given on the telehealth rules that are being created to implement HB 122 enacted (134th GA)

Presentation by OPHP

Nelson Heise, Clinical Director of Ohio Physicians Health Program (OPHP) gave a presentation regarding the SMBO partnership with OPHP relative to licensees obtaining confidential treatment for impairment. His presentation was subsequently emailed to the members of the RCAC.

Ohio Society for Respiratory Care (OSRC) Update

Sue Ciarlariello, OSRC legislative chair gave an update on behalf of the association regarding the upcoming statewide conference, the comments given by the OSRC during the CSI public comment period for the SMBO telehealth rules and the upcoming potential legislation for creating an additional SMBO license for Advance Practice Respiratory Care practitioners.

SMBO update

An update was given by Ms. Reardon regarding the number of RCP's whose licenses need to be renewed by June 31, 2022, and reminder about the license renewing schedule for the future.

Ms. Reardon also asked that the OSRC send out a reminder to the respiratory care educational institutions to remind the students who hold an L1 license to let the Board know when they graduate. Ms. Ciarlariello indicated that she would send out a reminder to all RCP's and to the institutions.

Ms. Reardon indicated that the full Board would be voting at it's June meeting on the reappointment of Amy Rodenhausen for a three year term beginning 4/11/22.

RCAC member, Matthew Munroe as asked to provide a brief presentation on his career and utilization of his RCP license.

The next meeting of the RCAC is scheduled for September 13, 2022 in person. Brandi Dorcy, SMBO Director of Compliance and Joseph Turek, SMBO Director of Licensing will be giving a presentation about the processes they manage.
