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Please find below a summary of actions taken or initiated by the State Medical Board of Ohio and an update of Board matters pending or decided in courts as of July 10, 2019.

**PRE-HEARING SUSPENSIONS**

**HERNANDEZ, Eric Omar, M.T., (#33.022761) – Rochester, New York**

Pursuant to Section 4731.22(G), license to practice massage therapy summarily suspended based on Board's determination that there is clear and convincing evidence that massage therapist is in violation of Section 4731.22(B)(26), Ohio Revised Code, and that his continued practice presents a danger of immediate and serious harm to the public. Order effective 7/10/2019. (See also: Citations/Proposed Denials below.)

**NAUM, George Philip, D.O., (#34.005389) - Wheeling, West Virginia**

Pursuant to Section 3719.121(C), Ohio Revised Code, doctor's license to practice is immediately suspended based upon a finding of guilt in the Northern District of West Virginia, to one count of Conspiracy to Distribute Controlled Substances Outside the Bounds of Professional Medical Practice; and four counts of Aiding and Abetting the Distribution of Controlled Substances Outside the Bounds of Professional Medical Practice. Order effective 7/10/2019. (See also; Citations/Proposed Denials below.)

**CITATIONS/PROPOSED DENIALS**

**BRACCIA, Domenick, D.O., (#34.004990) - Maple Glen, Pennsylvania**

Based on a 4/4/2019 Order of Temporary Suspension and Notice of Hearing by the State Board of Medicine of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, that temporarily suspended the doctor's license, that was based in part upon the Issuance of Presentment Number 32 by the Investigating Grand Jury which was accepted by the judge in the Court of Common Pleas, Montgomery County, Pennsylvania on or about March 12, 2019. The Pennsylvania Board action, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute any of the following actions taken by an agency responsible for authorizing, certifying, or regulating an individual to practice a health care occupation or provide health care services in this state or another jurisdiction, for any reason other than the nonpayment of fees: the limitation, revocation, or suspension of an individual's

license to practice; acceptance of an individual's license surrender; denial of a license; refusal to renew or reinstate a license; imposition of probation; or issuance of an order of censure or other reprimand. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**HERNANDEZ, Eric Omar, M.T., (#33.022761) - Rochester, New York**

Massage therapist notified of right to request a hearing on the question of whether his failure to submit to a chemical dependency examination as ordered by the Board was due to circumstances beyond his control. Based on the legal presumption that the massage therapist's failure to submit to a chemical dependency examination as ordered by the Board constitutes an admission that he is unable to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care by reason of his habitual or excessive use or abuse of drugs, alcohol, or other substances that impair ability to practice. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing on Failure to Submit to an Examination and Notice of Summary Suspension Based Upon Presumption of an Admission of Impairment mailed 7/11/2019.

**KOLLAB, Lara, D.O., (#58.030190) - Westlake, Ohio**

Based on: the doctor's admission to making anti-Semitic comments on social media, and then subsequently deleting the comments and falsely claiming that she was being framed for having made those comments; and on the doctor's 2/4/2019 sworn statement containing false statements; and on the doctor's 7/1/2018 resignation in lieu of termination from her internal medicine residency at the Cleveland Clinic, which became effective 10/18/2018; and on the doctor's failure to disclose during an interview with the Kerns Medical Center in California that her resignation was based on her discriminatory social media postings. The doctor's actions, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute: making a false, fraudulent, deceptive, or misleading statement in the solicitation of or advertising for patients; in relation to the practice of medicine and surgery, osteopathic medicine and surgery, podiatric medicine and surgery, or a limited branch of medicine; or in securing or attempting to secure any license or certificate to practice issued by the board. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**LAZZERINI, Frank Domenico, M.D., (#35.092741) - Lisbon, Ohio**

Based on the doctor's multiple felony convictions in the Court of Common Pleas of Stark County, Ohio, to Involuntary manslaughter, Aggravated Drug Trafficking, Drug Trafficking, Illegal Processing of Drug Documents, Medicaid Fraud, and Engaging in a Pattern of Corrupt Activity. The doctor's actions and conviction, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute a plea of guilty to, a judicial finding of guilt of, or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction for, a felony. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**MALIA, Van Lee, D.O., (#34.009216) - Grovetown, Georgia**

Based on an 4/11/2019 Public Consent Order issued by the Georgia Composite Medical board that reprimanded and fined the doctor five hundred dollars (\$500.00), wherein the doctor acknowledged he had entered into an employment contract and indicated that he was board

certified, when in fact he was not; and forged a letter from the American Osteopathic College of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation stating that he was certified. The prior action by the Georgia Board, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute any of the following actions taken by an agency responsible for authorizing, certifying, or regulating an individual to practice a health care occupation or provide health care services in this state or another jurisdiction, for any reason other than the nonpayment of fees: the limitation, revocation, or suspension of an individual's license to practice; acceptance of an individual's license surrender; denial of a license; refusal to renew or reinstate a license; imposition of probation; or issuance of an order of censure or other reprimand. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**MERTZ**, Marissa Maia, M.D., (#35.091568) - Columbus, Ohio

Based on an 10/10/2018 Opportunity for Hearing on Failure to Submit to an Examination and Notice of Summary Suspension Based on Presumption of an Admission of Impairment which resulted in a 3/13/2019 Step I Consent Agreement; also based on the doctor's failure to provide quarterly declarations due on 6/1/2019; also based on the doctor's failure to appear for a quarterly appearance on 6/13/2019; also based on the doctor's failure to submit to random toxicological screens, to call-in to drug testing facility, and enter into necessary financial/contractual arrangements; also based on the doctor's failure to provide the Board with documentary evidence of continuing compliance with an alcohol and drug rehabilitation program that were due 6/1/2019. The doctor's actions, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute a violation of the conditions of limitation placed by the board upon a license or certificate to practice. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**NAUM**, George Phillip, D.O., (#34.005389) - Wheeling, West Virginia

Based on the doctor's conviction in the Northern District of West Virginia, to one count of Conspiracy to Distribute Controlled Substances Outside the Bounds of Professional medical practice; and four counts of Aiding and Abetting the Distribution of Controlled Substances Outside the Bounds of Professional Medical Practice. The doctor's acts and conviction, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute: a plea of guilty to, a judicial finding of guilt of, or a judicial finding of eligibility for intervention in lieu of conviction for, a felony. Notice of Immediate Suspension and Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**SECURO**, Anthony Todde, M.D., Applicant - Columbus, Georgia

Based on the doctor's submission of an application to practice medicine and surgery; and also based on several prior actions by the Composite State Board of Medical Examiners of the state of Georgia including a 5/6/2004 Public Consent Order, that indefinitely suspended the doctor's license, a 12/1/2005 Public Consent Order Lifting Suspension, a 4/13/2007 Public Consent Order Permitting Practice with Conditions, a 10/2/2008 Amendment to Public Consent Order, a 6/5/2009 Second Amendment to Consent Order; a 10/10/2013 Amended Public Consent Order; and a 10/25/2017 Consent Order by the West Virginia Board of Medicine. The prior actions by the Georgia Board, and the West Virginia Board, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute any of the following actions taken by an agency responsible for

authorizing, certifying, or regulating an individual to practice a health care occupation or provide health care services in this state or another jurisdiction, for any reason other than the nonpayment of fees: the limitation, revocation, or suspension of an individual's license to practice; acceptance of an individual's license surrender; denial of a license; refusal to renew or reinstate a license; imposition of probation; or issuance of an order of censure or other reprimand. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**SIEFERT, W.L. Gregory, M.D., (#35.044005) - Granville, Ohio**

Based on a 5/3/2019 Agreed Order issued by the Board of Medical Licensure of the Commonwealth of Kentucky, that restricted/limited the doctor's license for an indefinite period of time by requiring that the doctor maintain a controlled substances log. The prior action by the Kentucky Board, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute any of the following actions taken by an agency responsible for authorizing, certifying, or regulating an individual to practice a health care occupation or provide health care services in this state or another jurisdiction, for any reason other than the nonpayment of fees: the limitation, revocation, or suspension of an individual's license to practice; acceptance of an individual's license surrender; denial of a license; refusal to renew or reinstate a license; imposition of probation; or issuance of an order of censure or other reprimand. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**WILLIAMS, Rodney Jay, M.D., Applicant - Reynoldsburg, Ohio**

Based on the submission of an application for a license to practice allopathic medicine and surgery; and also based on a 10/15/2015 surrender of the doctor's DEA registration to the Drug Enforcement Agency; and also based on a March 2019 Consent Agreement and a 11/22/2017 Order issued by the Pennsylvania Department of State, Bureau of Professional and Occupational Affairs that reprimanded the doctor's license and required the doctor to complete remedial education. The prior actions of the doctor, the DEA, and by the Pennsylvania Board, as alleged, would individually, and or collectively, constitute any of the following actions taken by an agency responsible for authorizing, certifying, or regulating an individual to practice a health care occupation or provide health care services in this state or another jurisdiction, for any reason other than the nonpayment of fees: the limitation, revocation, or suspension of an individual's license to practice; acceptance of an individual's license surrender; denial of a license; refusal to renew or reinstate a license; imposition of probation; or issuance of an order of censure or other reprimand; and the revocation, suspension, restriction, reduction, or termination of clinical privileges by the United States department of defense or department of veterans affairs or the termination or suspension of a certificate of registration to prescribe drugs by the drug enforcement administration of the United States department of justice. Notice of Opportunity for Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

Based on the massage therapist's submission of an application for restoration of license to practice massage therapy, and on allegations that the applicant has not been engaged in the active practice of massage therapy for more than two years. Notice of an Opportunity for a Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**MILLER**, Amy Alice, R.C.P., (#RCP.6183) – Lima, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)

Based on the respiratory care professional's submission of an application for restoration of license to practice respiratory care, and on allegations that the applicant has not been engaged in the active practice of respiratory care for more than two years. Notice of an Opportunity for a Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**PEREZ**, Tonie Lynn, R.C.P., (#RCP.1878) – Orlando, Florida (NON-DISCIPLINARY)

Based on the respiratory care professional's submission of an application for restoration of license to practice respiratory care, and on allegations that the applicant has not been engaged in the active practice of respiratory care for more than two years. Notice of an Opportunity for a Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

**RADER**, Jennifer L., M.T. (Applicant) – Toledo, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)

Based on the massage therapist's submission of an application to practice massage therapy, and on allegations that the applicant has not been engaged in the active practice of massage therapy for more than two years. Notice of an Opportunity for a Hearing mailed 7/11/2019.

### **FINAL ORDERS**

**ANGE**, Constance E., D.O., (#34.002359) - Centerville, Ohio

On the thirty-first day following the effective date of the order, the doctor's license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery is permanently revoked, and fined three thousand five hundred dollars (\$3,500.00). Based on the finding that with respect to the care of eight patients, the doctor failed to adequately assess, examine, treat or properly document various psychiatric disorders by not utilizing data from the Ohio Automated Rx Reporting System, and thereby the doctor failed to maintain minimal standards applicable to the selection or administration of drugs, or failed to employ acceptable scientific methods in the selection of drugs or other modalities for treatment of disease; and that the doctor departed from or failed to conform to minimal standards of care of similar practitioners under the same or similar circumstances; and that the doctor violated or attempted to violate, directly or indirectly, or assisted in or abetted the violation of, or conspired to violate Section 4731.22(B)(20), Ohio Revised Code to wit: General Provisions, Rule 4731-11-02, Ohio Administrative Code. Order effective 7/11/2019. Revocation effective 8/11/2019.

**DEMINT**, Franklin Donald, D.O., (#34.005493) - Kingston, Ohio

License to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery permanently revoked, and fined one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00). Based on the finding that the doctor violated the terms, conditions,

and limitations of the November 2014 Board Order, when the doctor tested positive for marijuana; and on the finding that the doctor is impaired in his ability to practice according to acceptable and prevailing standards of care because of habitual or excessive use or abuse of drugs, alcohol, or other substances that impair ability to practice. Order effective 7/23/2019.

**LARKY, Howard Chad, D.O., (#34.008280) - Columbus, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

Application for a certificate to recommend medical use of marijuana denied. Based on the doctor's submission of an application for a certificate to recommend medical use of marijuana; and also based on the finding that the doctor's 11/9/2011 Consent Agreement was based in whole or part on the doctor's inappropriate prescribing, personally furnishing, dispensing, diverting, administering, supplying or selling a controlled substance or other dangerous drug. Order effective 7/11/2019. (Journal Entry-No Hearing Requested).

**LIFKA, Alesha Lynne, M.T., (#33.020492) - Elyria, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

Application for restoration of license to practice massage therapy conditionally approved, provided that the massage therapist takes and passes the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Examination (MBLEx) within six months of the mailing of the Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing. Order effective 7/11/2019. (Journal Entry-No Hearing Requested).

**RAMADHIN, Abhishek, M.D., Applicant - Suwanee, Georgia (NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

Application for a license to practice allopathic medicine and surgery denied. Based on the doctor's submission of an application for a license to practice allopathic medicine and surgery; and also based on the finding that the doctor has not successfully completed two years of graduate medical education through the second-year level of training, or its equivalent as determined by the Board. Order effective 7/11/2019. (Journal Entry-No Hearing Requested).

**RINGENBACH, Laura Ann , R.C.P., Applicant - Dalton, Ohio**

License to practice respiratory care granted, subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for at least five years, and permanently restricted from practicing respiratory care: for agencies providing home care; in-home hospice care; for staffing agencies or pools; as an independent provider when services are reimbursed by the state of Ohio; or for an individual or group who directly engage the licensee to provide respiratory care services for fees, compensation, or other consideration or as a volunteer. Based on the respiratory care professional's submission of an application for a license to practice respiratory care in which she disclosed a prior action by the Ohio Board of Nursing, that issued a 5/20/2011 Consent Agreement indefinitely suspending her nursing license and establishing conditions for reinstatement and permanent restrictions. Order effective 7/11/2019.

**ROSS, John Allen, M.D., (#35.064459) - Fostoria, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

Application for a certificate to recommend medical use of marijuana denied. Based on the doctor's submission of an application for a certificate to recommend medical use of marijuana;

and also based on the finding that the doctor's 8/12/2015 Consent Agreement was based in whole or part on the doctor's inappropriate prescribing, personally furnishing, dispensing, diverting, administering, supplying or selling a controlled substance or other dangerous drug. Order effective 7/11/2019.

**SMITH, Randy Michael, D.O., (#34.013221) - Miamisburg, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

Application for a certificate to recommend medical use of marijuana denied. Based on the doctor's submission of an application for a certificate to recommend medical use of marijuana; and also based on the finding that the doctor does not currently hold an active, unrestricted license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery, because his license is currently suspended per a 4/10/2019 Consent Agreement. Order effective 7/11/2019. (Journal Entry-No Hearing Requested).

**WALDORF, Monica Shane, M.T., (#33.018949) - Gahanna, Ohio (NON-DISCIPLINARY)**

Application for restoration of license to practice massage therapy conditionally approved, provided that the massage therapist takes and passes the Massage and Bodywork Licensing Examination (MBLEx) within six months of the mailing of the Notice of Opportunity for a Hearing. Order effective 7/11/2019. (Journal Entry-No Hearing Requested).

License to practice medicine and surgery reprimanded, and subject a ten thousand dollar (\$10,000.00) fine, and general probationary terms for at least two years. Based on the doctor's admission that with respect to the care and treatment of twelve specified patients, the doctor failed to properly document patient treatment within patient charts; document appropriate pre-operative preparation; exercise appropriate intra-operative decision making; inconsistent patient pathology in operative reports; appropriately manage post-operative care; perform appropriate surgical techniques; and document appropriate referrals. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

**AMORN, Allen Michael, M.D., (#35.124017) - Mason, Ohio**

Doctor's license subject to probationary terms, conditions, and limitations for at least one year. Based on the doctor's admission that in December 2018 he was hospitalized for depression, but has since successfully completed intensive outpatient treatment; and on the doctor's admission that that he pled guilty to two amended charges of Disorderly Conduct that were related to the December 2018 hospitalization. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

**DALE, Roman Michael, M.D., (#35.068153) - Cleveland, Ohio**

License to practice medicine and surgery indefinitely suspended for at least one year, and subject to general probationary requirements, and conditions for reinstatement. Based on the doctor's

admission that he engaged in sexual misconduct with respect to the care and treatment of one specified patient. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

**GANTNER**, Thomas James, P.A., (#50.003782RX) - Columbus, Ohio

Physician assistant's license to practice reinstated, and subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for at least five years. Based on the physician assistant having completed all requirements for reinstatement of license pursuant to the terms of the 12/13/2017 Consent Agreement. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

**GUPTA**, Pankaj Chand, M.D., (#35.099606) - Cleveland, Ohio

Doctor's license to practice medicine and surgery reinstated effective 8/1/2019, and subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for at least one year. Based on the doctor having completed all requirements for reinstatement of license pursuant to the terms of the 12/12/2018 Consent Agreement. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

**SILK**, Jon Berkeley, M.D., (#35.098705) - Troy, Ohio

License to practice medicine and surgery indefinitely suspended for at least one year, subject to general probationary requirements, conditions for reinstatement including entering in a subsequent consent agreement. Based on the doctor's admission that on or about November and/or December 2016 he had a second relapse on alcohol; and on the doctor's admission that he has been diagnosed with and being treated for Generalized Anxiety Disorder. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

**VERCHIO**, Melissa Lynn, M.D., (#35.124228) - Cuyahoga Falls, Ohio

Doctor's license to practice medicine and surgery reinstated, and subject to probationary terms, conditions and limitations for at least five years. Based on the doctor having completed all requirements for reinstatement of license pursuant to the terms of the 3/13/2019 Consent Agreement. Agreement effective 7/10/2019.

Decision and Judgment Entry filed 7/1/2019 in the Court of Common Pleas, Franklin County, Ohio wherein the Court affirmed and also reversed in part, the 4/13/2017 Board Order, concluding that the reprimand was not in accordance with law, and for the application for restoration of license to practice osteopathic medicine and surgery to be granted.
